DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

PRE-SOAK: To soften soil material on silverware, (including cream rings in silver creamers, pre-soak all silver in a 1 to 2 ounces per gallon solution prior to machine washing. For faster results you can use hot water.

DETARNISHING: For the removal of sulfur type tarnish and stain dilute 2 ounces per gallon in warm or hot water. Silver should be in contact with aluminum to facilitate the galvanic action necessary to detarnish. Aluminum foil should be placed in the bottom of a plastic container.
